#### Pastor Reflections:

If you and I were to go out and conduct a survey and ask people what Christians believe, you might hear them say things like, "Well, Christians believe that Jesus was the Son of God and that they believe he was raised from the dead." And then if you were to ask them how Christians live, they might tell you that Christians don't seem to live any differently from anyone else. In my opinion, there is great truth to this observation. And, so its understandable why so many people have written off Christianity. While Jesus gets high marks, Christianity and the church get low marks.

In the book of Acts we are told that the early Christians were known as the "people of the way'...that is, the way of Jesus. The main reason that people joined the church in droves was that in their world that was full of despair and poverty ... a world full of violence and coercive power...people found that Christians were actually living in a different and loving and hopeful way.


There is passage in Acts where the early Christians were accused of turning the world upside down. They loved their enemies. They forgave. They refused to take up the sword but were non-violent. They were generous beyond measure and shared their possessions and provided for the poor. They lived with hope and joy. They treated people with dignity and included those whom society and the empire excluded. Even the pagan Roman Emperor Julian remarked about the people of The Way...."The godless Galileans feed our poor in addition to their own." In this turning the world upside down, the last become first and the powerful and rich are brought low. It's really turning the world right side up, as God intended it.

Fellow followers of the way of Jesus...Church...Cayce UMC...we are called to live in a different way...This is our summons and this is our joy. Very recently we had five people, Alec Biller, Olivia Clay, Eddie Redleaf, Leila Finley-Redleaf, and Linda Watts join our church here at Cayce. What an honor for us! They want to be a part of a community of faith where the life of Jesus can be replicated and realized. We need their gifts and graces and presence to help us to better as people who are living in a different way. What do you and I need to be about if we are truly to be the body of Christ... the hands and feet and heart of Jesus in this world? How can we be better together? We give thanks that these people deem us worthy and that thy would want to join with us. Let us join with them and let us join again with one another and with Christ.



It's that time again. Budget requests for 2026 will be due in the church office no later than **October 31 2025.** Copies are available on the table outside the church office or feel free to contact Cynthia.

#### REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS

To make an IRA donation to charity, individuals age 70 1/2 or older can make Qualified Charitable Distributions of up to \$108,000 per year directly from their IRA to a qualified charity. The funds must be transferred by the IRA custodian to the charity to be excluded from the donor's taxable income and counted towards their Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). This method is separate from the typical income tax deduction for charitable contributions and is limited to itemizers. If you have any questions, please ask your financial advisor or bank.


